
Volta Wildlife Area Hunt Map

INFORMATION FOR HUNTING ON THE VOLTA WILDLIFE AREA

OPERATION OF THIS AREA IS CONDUCTED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND WILDLIFE IN COOPERATION WITH THE U.S. BUREAU OF RECLAMATION

- 1. Once a hunter has left the parking lot, he may possess no more than 25 shotgun shells. FEDERALLY APPROVED NONTOXIC SHOT IS REQUIRED FOR ALL HUNTING.
- 2. Loaded guns are prohibited in parking areas.
- 3. Hunters must park in assigned parking lots. All persons must be off the area by one and one-half hours after sunset.
- 4. Hunters with boats may drive beyond Parking Lot 1, to launch boats at the bridge. Vehicle and trailer must be returned to Parking Lot 1 after launching.
- 5. Only six boats will be allowed on the area. There is a maximum of four persons per boat.
- 6. Hunters must possess a valid hunting license, stamps and Area Permit while in the field.
- 7. The area is open to hunting of waterfowl, coots, moorhens, pheasant and snipe when in season. Areas closed to hunting are posted.
- 8. Permits will be issued at the checking station on Saturdays, Sundays and Wednesdays, starting two hours before shooting time during the waterfowl season.
- 9. Shooting hours for waterfowl are one-half (1/2) hour before sunrise to sunset.
- 10. All hunters must check in and out of the checking station and <u>return permits and declare take</u> upon leaving.
- 11. Shooting days and hours are posted at the checking station.
- 12. Dogs must be leashed at checking station and at parking lots.
- 13. ALL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE PROHIBITED IN THE FIELD.
