Abstracts Due: February 10th, 2023

Greetings Interagency Ecological Program Colleagues:

The organizers of the 2023 Interagency Ecological Program (IEP) Workshop are soliciting abstracts for poster presentations. The workshop will be held at the California Natural Resources Agency (CNRA) headquarters at 715 "P" Street in Sacramento, CA on March 21-24, 2023.

The Poster Session will be held as a regular session of the workshop on March 21-22 with posters available for viewing on the 2nd floor conference rooms.

All IEP poster abstract submissions must include:

- Author(s) full names and affiliations, including mailing address, phone, and email address.
- Title, briefly composed in sentence case format.
- Abstract, in 300 words or less. See attached template on page 3.
- Identify presenting author and denote if eligible for the early career scientist award (graduation within 5 years).

To help us categorize the posters, identify the category your poster is to be included in:

- Delta Smelt & Longfin Smelt
- Invasive Species
- Lower Food Webs
- Resident Fishes
- Salmon & Sturgeon
- Water Quality
- Potpourri (any poster that does not fit the other categories)

Due to limited space, we may not be able to accept all poster submissions. Please submit a separate paragraph of 50 words or less describing the statement of relevance of your work to the management and restoration of the habitat, and native and non-native species within the San Francisco Estuary.

The deadline for poster abstracts is February 10th.

Due to space considerations, we are limiting submissions to one poster per primary author. Submit IEP abstracts to Anna Feerick (afeerick@ucdavis.edu) with the subject line: IEP Abstract Submission - "Presenting Author Name Here".
